Wet Forest (EVC 30) and Damp Forest (EVC 29). Plant species in the higher hills and gullies. Look for remnant vegetation in paddocks, on roadsides and in gullies nearby.

Lowland Forest (EVC 16) and Herb-rich Foothill Forest (EVC 23). Messmate/Peppermint forest is found on the lower hills with heavier soils. This is a general guide of species from which to select. Ideally identify plants growing close to your site and in a similar situation so that a list appropriate to your site can be worked out with the nursery. If you are not sure of the species take branchlets (with flowers if possible) to the nursery to be identified.
